Enclosed please find a generic Chemical Hygiene Plan (CHP) required by the OSHA Standard Occupational Exposure to Hazardous Chemicals in the Laboratory (29 CFR Part 1910.1450). This is the next OSHA standard to be implemented in the ongoing process of bringing the University into compliance.

This is a generic plan, designed so that each administrative unit (laboratory, department, or college) is able to amend it to their specific situations. The OSHA Standard is also included in this packet to use as a reference to ensure that information required by the standard is present in the CHP.
