3 p.m. - Contest Begins at Open Class Dairy Barn  
7:30 p.m. - Awards Presentation, Hunter Arena  
Following Results - Square Dancing and Line Dancing by Coshocton County Farm Bureau

**WHO:** Any and all 2008 4-H and FFA members, clubs, and chapters in Ohio.

**DEADLINE FOR ENTERING IS SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 27<sup>th</sup>. NO ENTRY FEE. \$8 each to enter fairgrounds.** (\$8 ticket includes rides and must be bought at the gate.)

A one-day pass at \$5 each or 7 admissions for \$25 can be purchased before September 27<sup>th</sup> by writing the Coshocton County Agricultural Society, 707 Kenilworth Ave., Coshocton, Ohio 43812 or phoning 740-622-2385. (These \$5.00 and \$25.00 passes do not include rides.)

### **COSHOCTON COUNTY GENERAL LIVESTOCK JUDGING CONTEST**

1. All contestants will be limited to students enrolled in 4-H or FFA program over the state of Ohio.
2. NO ENTRY FEE.
3. There will be a Junior Team & Individual (age 8-13) Divisions and Senior team & Individual (age 14 & older) Divisions. Ages are determined as of January 1 of the current year. If teams are mixed (Junior & Senior) the team will compete in the Senior Division (age as of January 1st.)
4. A team will consist of at least 3 member, but not more than 4 members. Three highest scores will be used to determine the team score. Individual entries may compete for the individual awards.
5. Each entry form must be signed by the 4-H Advisor or FFA Advisor.
6. While the contest is in progress, there shall be no communication between contestants and anyone else, except the person in charge of the ring.
7. Only designated group leaders will be allowed to give instructions or to help contestants fill out judging cards.
8. Five team and five individual rosettes will be awarded in each division. Awards for Top Junior Individual and Top Senior Individual. Special awards of show equipment, feeding supplies, etc. will be awarded to Coshocton County 4-H/and or FFA members only who place in the contest.
9. Classes will be:
  1. Market Steer
  2. Market Hogs
  3. Market Lambs
  4. Breeding Ewes
  5. Beef Breeding Heifers
  6. Breeding Gilts
10. Each class will consist of placing four animals. Five questions will be asked on three of the classes.
