For the style review, members may arrive to dress in their outfits at 5:45 p.m. (not before). Members should be dressed & ready to line up by 6:20 p.m.

**PRE-REGISTRATION FOR 2008 INTERVIEW JUDGING
FAMILY LIVING AND SPECIAL INTEREST PROJECTS**

Family Living and Special Interest project interview judging will be conducted on an appointment basis. Guidelines are as follows:

1. Pre-registration will open on June 20 and close the Friday preceding each evaluation day.
2. All pre-registration must be done in person at the Extension Office. No phone registration will be taken. Cancellation may be done by phone, re-scheduling must be done in person.
3. Members may be registered by him/herself, parents or advisors. Whomever registers a member is responsible for notifying that member and/or parent(s).
4. Members should arrive 5-10 minutes before their interview time. Members who pre-register will have first choice to fill the time slot of someone who is late or doesn't show. Members who are late may have to reschedule for another time slot if we cannot trade their time with another person.
5. **Members taking multiple projects should allow at least 1 hour between interviews. (Example: 10:00 and 11:00)**
6. Members who do not pre-register prior to Evaluation Day will be able to select their evaluation time from open time slots when they arrive on Evaluation Day. **Members without appointments should arrive in the morning to be sure of fitting into the schedule. Arrival after Noon will not guarantee a judging time.**

4-H MEMBER INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Arrive 5-10 minutes before your interview time.
2. Sign in at registration table. Obtain 2 judge=s comment sheets and fill out top of both.
3. Related Projects: Report to appropriate table when called.
4. Foods Projects: Set up your table in cafeteria area as directed. Do not bring a place setting, centerpiece, or decorations. Materials will be provided for members to set appropriate place setting.
5. Clothing Projects: **Members will first carry their finished project into the judge for the interview. After the interview, the member will return immediately for the second step – wearing the completed project for the Total Look@ judging.**
6. Complete interview and clear the area when finished.
7. Pick up your copy of comment sheet at registration table 5 minutes after interview. You are free to leave.

Additional Information For Clothing Projects:

1. **Members must participate in Style Review to be eligible for county winner and state fair placings.**
2. **Members must participate in the practice modeling session either before or after their evaluation. DO NOT change clothes until AFTER the practice modeling session.**
3. Every member must complete a style narration for each garment they will model in the Style Review. Information should be written neatly in sentences and ready for narrator to read. Narrations may be filled out prior to judging and **must be turned in at the registration table on Monday, July 21.**
4. All members should wear their accessories for evaluation. Refer to "Total Look" insert in project book.
5. **Members should bring hangers and hang their garments on racks in designated area. Members and judges ONLY are to be in this area.**
6. It's Time for Clothing: Members in these projects are required to attend Style Review, write a 1 Minute summation of project work, and recite/read summation during the Style Review.

Clothing evaluations will be a two-part procedure. Members will first carry their finished project into the judge for the interview. After the interview, the member will return immediately for the second step - wearing the completed project for the Total Look judging. Clothing will still be left for the judges to make a final inspection.
