Continuing Education Course Development Grants up to \$15,000 a year for up to 3 years. Due April 15 or October 15.

Funded from the Office of Continuing Education, these grants support faculty in adapting credit and non-credit courses delivered using non-traditional teaching and learning formats that target an expanded learner base. Non-credit courses must show potential to become credit courses in the future.

OSU CARES/OSU Extension Seed Grants up to \$7,500. Due April 15.

This program under the leadership of OSU Extension funds outreach and engagement initiatives that partner at least two departments (including OSU Extension) for enhanced outreach and engagement.

P-12 Scholars up to \$20,000. Due April 15.

Funded through the P-12 Initiative, these grants provide incentives to initiate or advance research leading to increased understanding of and involvement in issues related to P-12 education.
