

**OSU Collegiate 4-H General Meeting
January 21, 2009**

The January 21st meeting was called to order at 7:30pm in the Agricultural Engineering building room 103 by President Joe Zimmerman. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Garrison Fogt and the 4-H pledge was led by Jarred Molesky.

The Secretary's Report was given. Shea McConahay moved to approve the minutes as e-mailed to members. Alissa Hunter seconded the motion and the motion was approved. Treasurer Garrison Fogt gave a Treasurer's Report of \$3,056.28 and members were reminded to pay their dues. Brent Diller made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and Stephanie Freshour seconded the motion. The motion passed.

In Officer Reports, President Joe Zimmerman gave the Education Officer report. The first educational trips are coming quickly and volunteers are needed to go to them. Collegiate volunteers are needed to help with the National 4-H Conference (high school age) in Washington, D.C. Applications are due January 30th and anyone interested should talk to Shea.

The only Committee Report given was by Plowboy Prom Chair Beth Bianco. This year's Plowboy Prom will be held February 14th at the State 4-H Office and the theme will be "Good Time." Members need to sign-up for sub-committees to help with the event.

In Old Business, club t-shirts are \$9 each. The club's bid to hold the North Central Region Conference later this year is being worked on.

During New Business, members need to sign the Thank You cards from CNI. Alissa Hunter made a motion to reimburse Social Officer Brent Diller \$75 for the cost of intramurals registration. Stephanie Freshour seconded the motion and the motion carried. Members discussed the proposed community service projects and voted to work at the Ronald MacDonald House. It received 11 votes, the Salvation Army received 0 votes, Habitat for Humanity 4 votes, and the soup kitchens 0 votes.

There were no announcements made.

Brooke Diller made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Stephanie Freshour seconded the motion. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned by President Joe Zimmerman.
