

**OSU Collegiate 4-H General Meeting  
February 11, 2009**

The February 11<sup>th</sup> meeting was called to order at 7:30pm in the Agricultural Engineering building room 103 by President Joe Zimmerman. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Garrison Fogt and the 4-H pledge was led by Nicholas Fisher.

Michelle Schroeder made a motion to suspend the reading of the Secretary's Minutes. Alissa Hunter seconded the motion and the motion was approved. Treasurer Garrison Fogt gave a Treasurer's Report of \$3,002.28. Kristen Corry made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Megan Johns seconded the motion and the motion carried.
