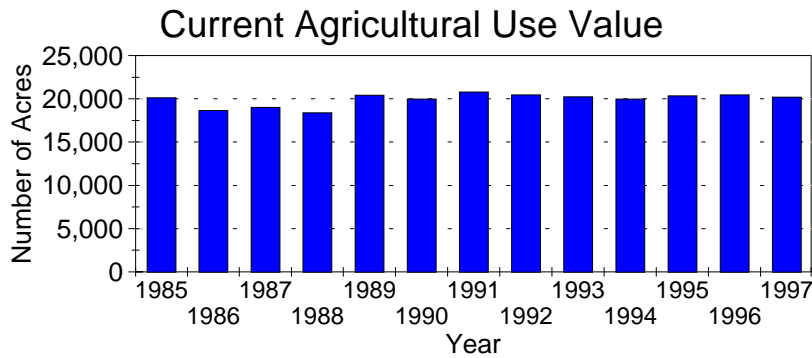

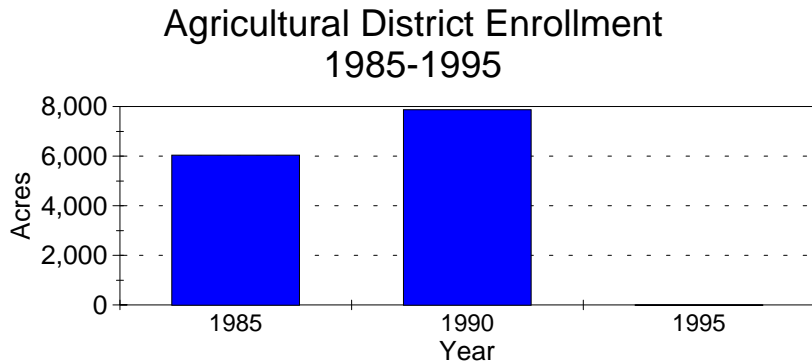

Agricultural District Enrollment



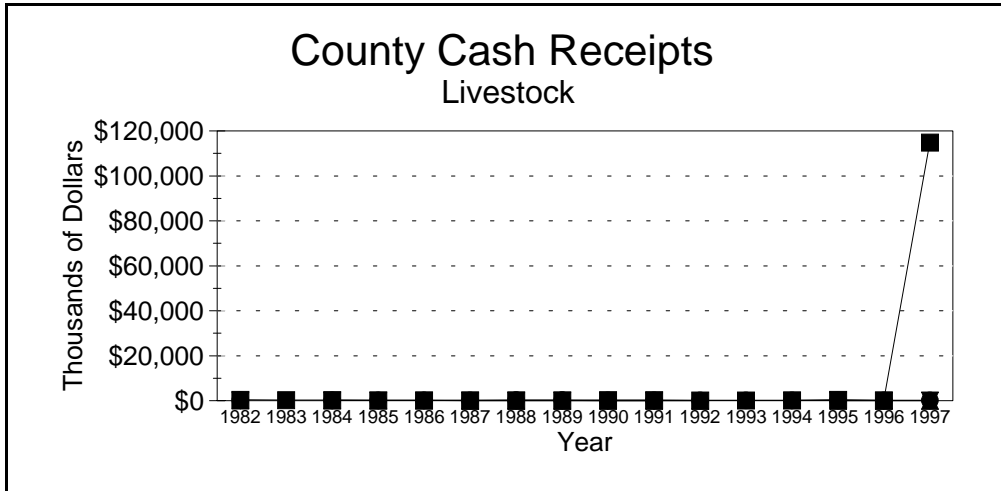

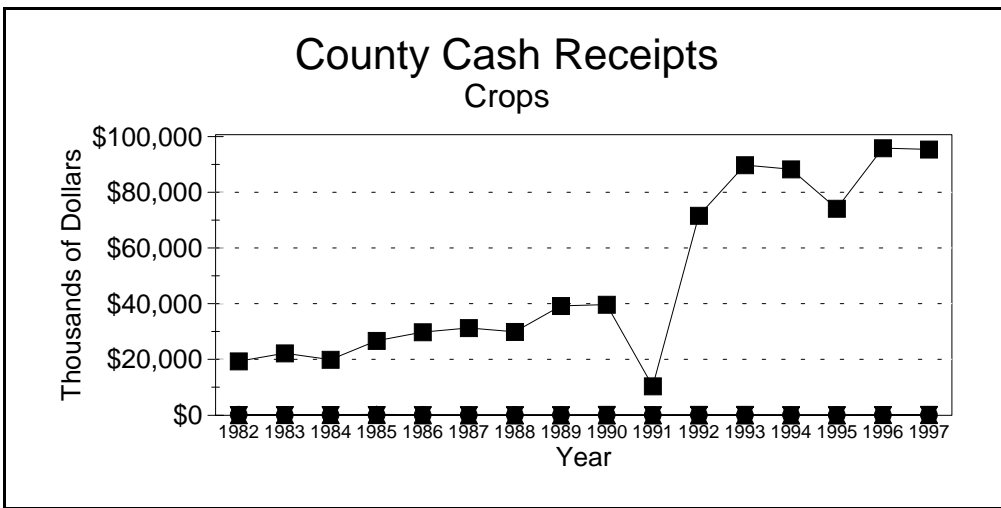

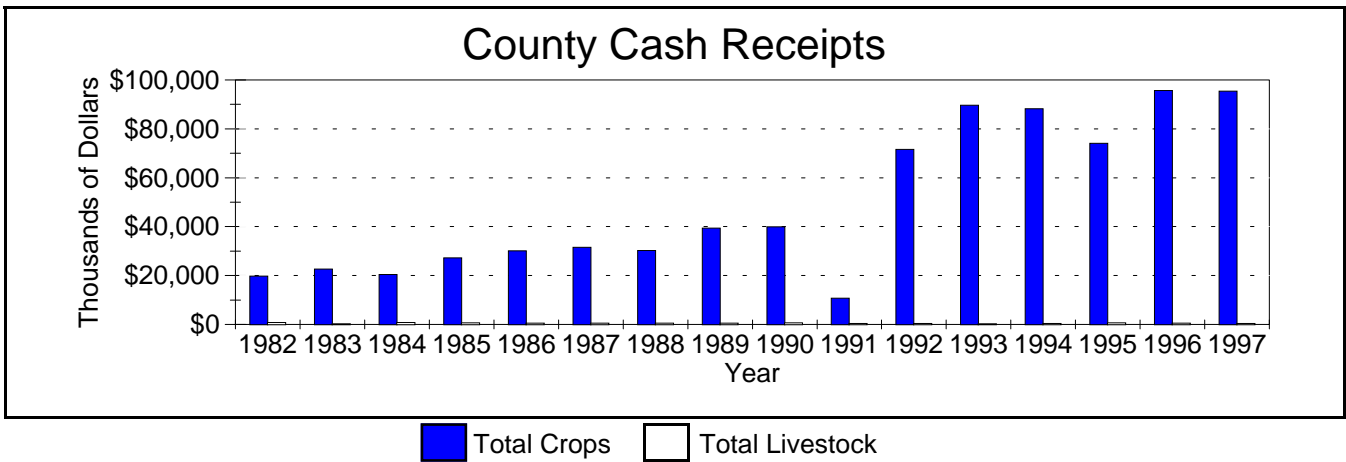
Cash Receipts

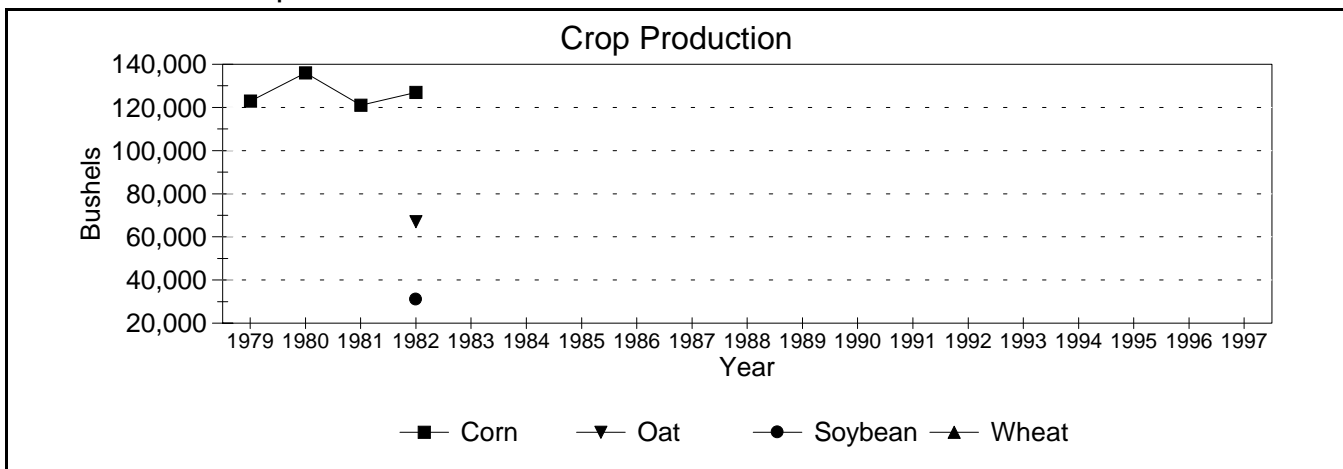

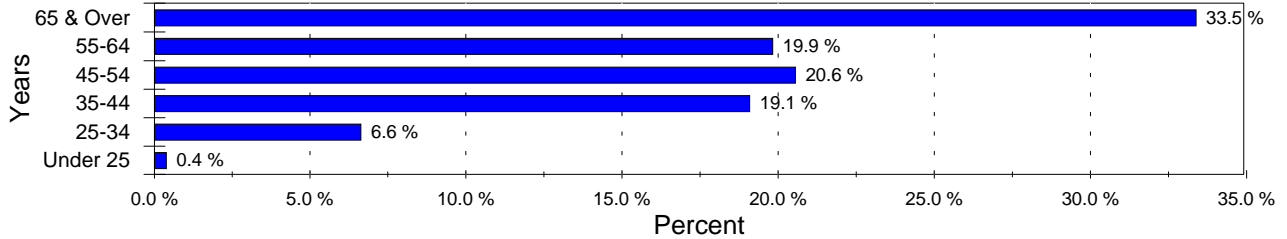

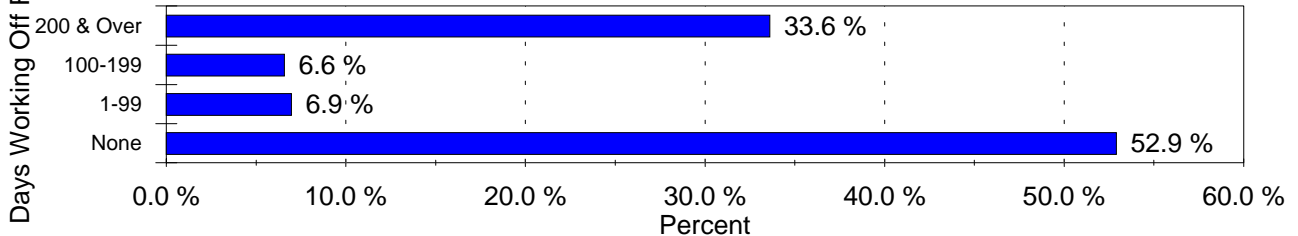
