

Taxes & Incentives in Noble County

Noble County has been the home of steady economic development since the 1950s. It offers a strong total economic package, including low land costs, low tax rates and other benefits.

Tax Information

- Real property tax rates vary by jurisdiction and range from 48.50 to 56.20 mills
- Of the 11.00 mills for county purposes:
 - 3.10 — General Fund
 - 1.00 — Health Department
 - 0.70 — Mental Health
 - 2.50 — MRDD
 - 1.00 — Ambulance Service
 - 1.20 — Jail Construction
 - 0.40 — Senior Citizens
 - 1.00 — Extension Service
- Local rates include a 5% State, and 1% County retail sales tax

Enterprise Zone

- Available in Noble and Olive Townships.
- Can reduce taxes on new products by up to 60%.
- Available on real property, tangible personal property, and on inventory.
