

Transportation in Noble County

“The County That Moves Mountains”

Noble County, unlike many “scenic rural areas,” is blessed with strong transportation access and availability. This includes three exits to north-south I-77 which intersects east-west I-70 just 20 minutes to the north. Couple this with nearby airports and easy access to the Ohio River for a wide variety of transportation options.

Highways

- Interstate 77 (north-south)
- Interstate 70 (east-west), 20 minutes
- State Routes: 78 (east-west), 285, 564, 821 (north-south)
- Truck: 3 motor freight lines

Airports

Noble County Airpark

- 3,800-foot runway
- 400-foot overrun

Nearby airports:

- Columbus; Akron-Canton; Cleveland; Parkersburg, WV; Charleston, WV; Pittsburgh, PA

Barge

- 30 minutes south via I-77 to the intermodal ports on the Ohio River
