**Read and Understand the Rules for 2007 Ohio State Fair Junior Fair Dog Show Participation to make sure you and/or your dog are eligible for each class entered.**

#### Rules to Remember When Entering Dogs and Classes:

1. You must complete a Drill Team Entry Form if you are showing one of the above dogs or a different dog in Drill Team competition. Alternates must register on the Drill Team Entry Form, postmarked by July 13, to avoid paying a late fee.
2. If showing in Agility you must complete an Agility Entry Form and submit it, along with processing fees, by July 18, 6:00pm. You may enter any number of project dogs in Agility.
3. If you are showing in **Dog Care**, either J-DC1 (Junior Dog Care), J-DC2 (Intermediate Dog Care), or J-DC3 (Senior Dog Care), **YOU CANNOT SHOW THAT SAME DOG OR ANY OTHER DOG IN ANY OTHER CLASSES AT THE STATE FAIR DOG SHOW**, including agility, any obedience, showmanship, rally, team, brace, assistance dogs, and drill team. You can enter the poster contest and participate in the skillathon.
4. Assistance Dogs can **ONLY** be shown in J-19 the Assistance Dog class. If you are showing an Assistance Dog, you can show other project dog(s) in eligible classes.
5. You can show more than one project dog, except if you are showing in Dog Care.
  - You can show different dogs in different levels of obedience provided you and your dog(s) are eligible to show at those levels. For example, one dog might be eligible to be shown in Sub-Novice B and a second dog eligible to be shown in Novice A (if you or that dog have never shown in Novice classes or above). A second example: One dog might be eligible to be shown in Novice B, a second dog eligible for Graduate Open B, and a third dog eligible for Open A (if you or your dog have never shown in Open classes or above). Make sure you and your dog are eligible for the obedience classes you enter. Once you **and** your dog have shown in an "A" class, you **and** your dog can **never** show in that same "A" class or any lower obedience classes again. If you have a second or a new dog, you can **never** show in an "A" class that you have previously shown in, even with the second or a new dog. You must show in the "B" class that your dog is eligible for. A dog can **NEVER** show in lower level class once it has competed at that level. If a dog has a different handler, that dog must be shown in the class it is eligible for. For Example: A 10-year old child is showing a dog that was last shown at the Graduate Novice A level. That child and dog must now show at the Graduate Novice B level, because of the dog's level of experience.
  - You can show the same or a different dog in Grooming & Handling. You can show only **ONE** dog in Grooming & Handling because of the age level restrictions. For example: You are 16 years old and you **OR** your dog has Grooming & Handling experience. You **MUST** show in J-18 Grooming & Handling Sr. B. Even if your dog does not have experience at that level, you do, so you must enter J-18.
  - You can show the same or a different project dog in Drill Team, Brace, Team, and Rally provided you and your dog meet eligibility requirements.
  - You may enter two project dogs per Rally class.
